The official website describes it as:

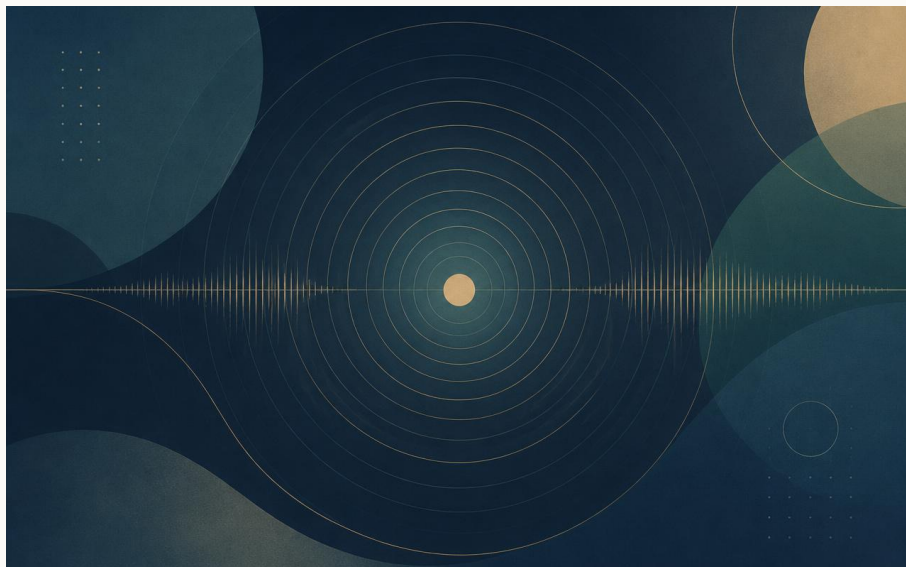

Who it is for

What the website claims

- It can be used in the comfort of your own home, on any device.

These are the website's own claims, presented in soft wording. They are not guarantees, and they have not been evaluated by the FDA.

How it claims to work

The official website's explanation is short, and we are not going to inflate it. The site states that a team of sound engineers and neuroscientists created a 12-minute audio experience that gently guides the brain toward Theta activity, using safe, non-invasive sound frequencies.

What that means for you in practice

- You press play. There is no protocol to learn and nothing to measure.
- It is sound only — nothing enters your body, so there is nothing to interact with medication.
- The commitment is fixed and small, which is why it survives a bad week.

What the site does not show

The official website includes scientific references related to the product, but it does not publish a clinical trial of this specific audio. We have not independently verified the referenced research. Treat the mechanism as a plausible, marketed explanation — not as proven medical fact.

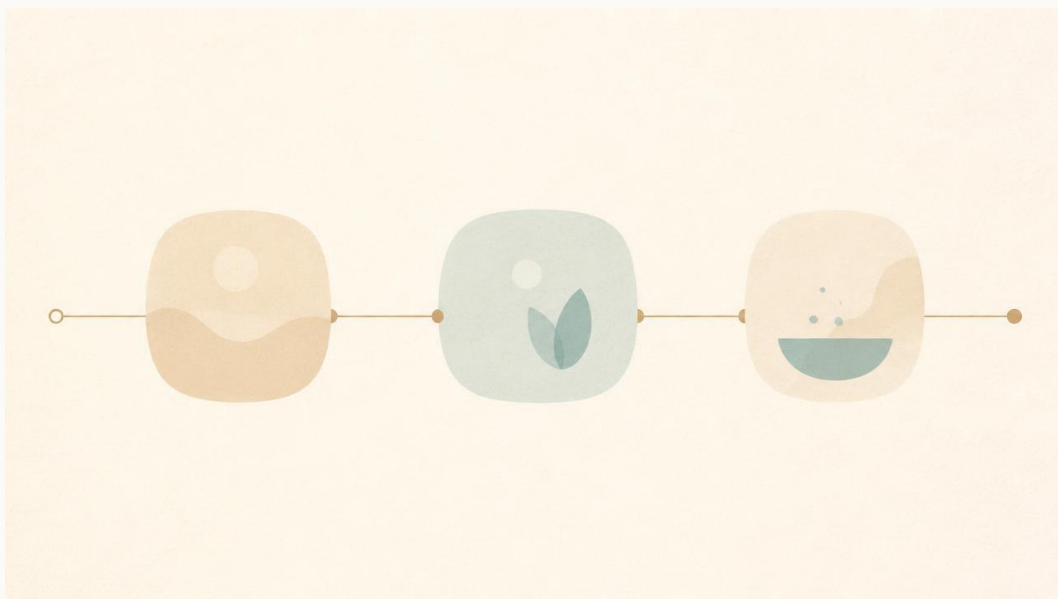

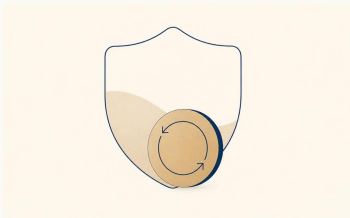
